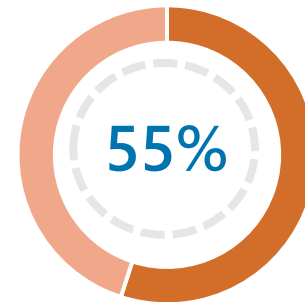
## ABOUT STATE PUBLIC HEALTH

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## CDC 2018 OPIOID OVERDOSE CRISIS FUNDING

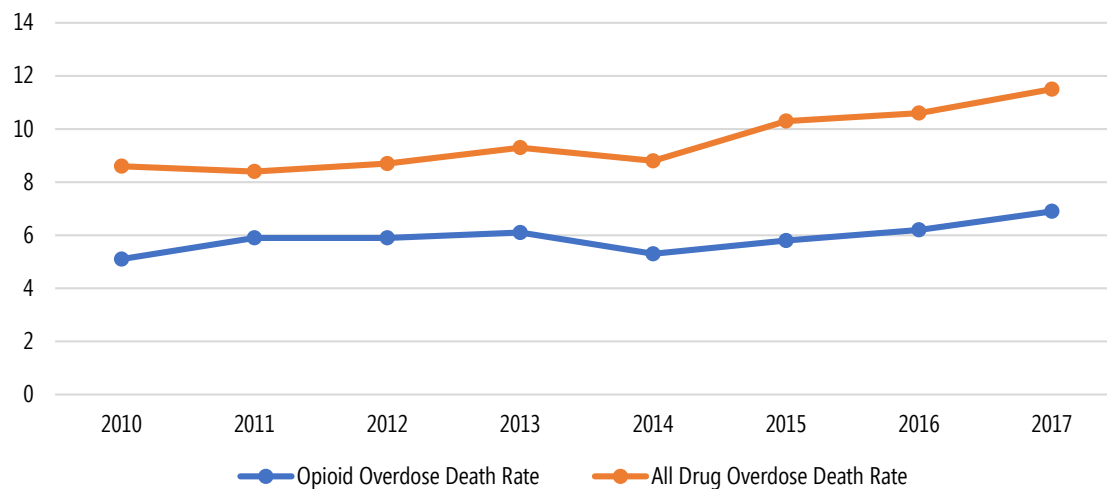
**Year 1 (FY18) \$2,275,265**

This funding will support Iowa in working to prevent opioid-related overdoses, deaths, and other outcomes. It will advance the understanding of the epidemic and scale-up prevention and response activities, including improving the timeliness of data. Specifically:

- Implementing an on-site electronic data collection system for medical examiners state-wide
- Development of a vulnerability assessment for HIV/HCV outbreaks
- Integrating opioid related data into the state's online data portal
- Improving the state's Substance Use Disorder treatment data collection system
