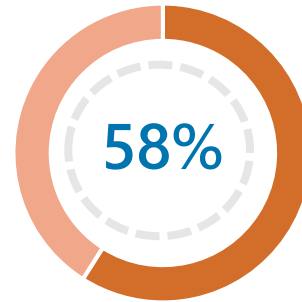

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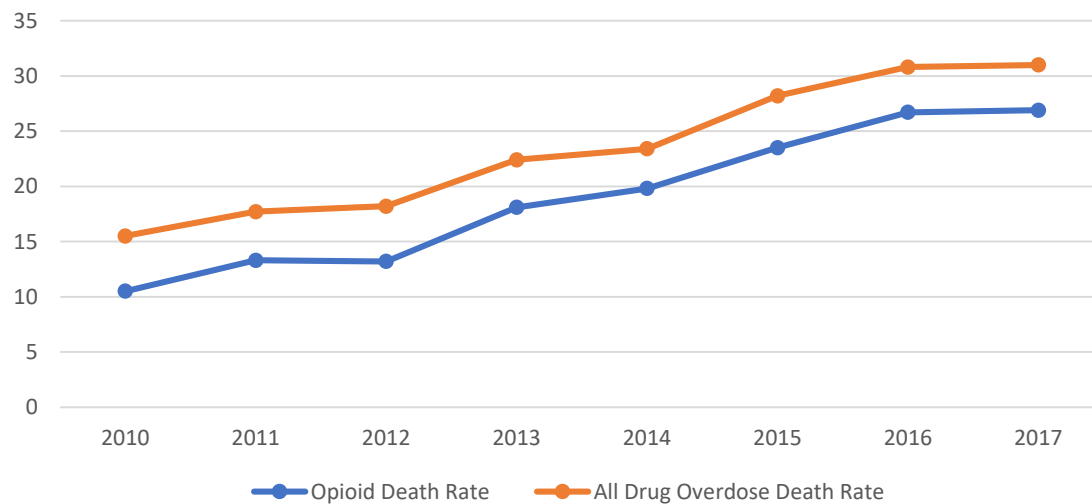
CDC 2018 OPIOID OVERDOSE CRISIS FUNDING

Year 1 (FY18) \$2,167,007

This funding will support Rhode Island in working to prevent opioid-related overdoses, deaths, and other outcomes. It will advance the understanding of the epidemic and scale-up prevention and response activities, including improving the timeliness of data.
